In May 2018, REDIB - Red Iberoamericano de Investigación y Conocimiento, in partnership with Clarivate Analytics, published the REDIB Magazine Ranking. In this 750 ranking, with more than journals, RIAEE ranks 22nd overall (https://redib.org/recursos/Ranking/Revista?id_revista=2532&lng=pt). Specifically in the area of Social Sciences and Humanities, we are in 8th place in the ranking and we 1st place in Brazil (<https://redib.org/recursos/Ranking/Revistas>). classification is the result of the efforts of the editorial team, the management policies of the RIAEE, and all the authors who have honored us with their work.

We reinforce the need for authors to follow standards, guidelines, formatting for submission, and use the template for articles. We remind you of the importance of submitting the declaration of originality and authorship, with copies of the RG and CPF, signed and digitized. When sending the declaration, the file must be in PDF. These have been the first evaluation items.

We would like to thank everyone who has given RIAEE its time and skills: authors, referees, advisors, editorial bodies, and auxiliaries. We also thank the fellow editors of other magazines who have taught us so much; to the entities that militate in the academic publishing - ABEC and FEPAE, in particular.

We want to keep this editorial space open to contributions that deepen analysis and knowledge in Education, so that we can spread the freedom, democracy, autonomy, reflection, creativity and criticality of Ibero-American educational thinking.
