Despite these areas for improvement, the study makes a significant contribution to youth studies in the context of social change, with intersections across the political, educational, and cultural domains.

The article clearly highlights the importance of investigating the relationship between politics and youth lifestyle, contextualizing the discussion within the current landscape of globalization, digital transformation, and sociocultural shifts. The authors analyze various dimensions of the relationship between politics, society, and lifestyle.

Li, Liu, and Solangi (2024), Fadli et al. (2022), and Zhu et al. (2024) discuss the role of cooperatives in sustainable development, emphasizing the importance of public policies developed collaboratively by the state, communities, and citizens—particularly in the context of provincial-level tourism.

Najafi (2023), Musto (2021), and Dafermos (2022) explore politics from a Marxist perspective, framing it as an expression of class relations and a tool for maintaining or transforming the social order. Theocharis, de Moor, and Van Deth (2021), along with Piscitelli and D'Uggento (2022) and Gheihman (2021), investigate how intensive use of social media has transformed the way young people interact, influencing their lifestyles and political engagement, while simultaneously creating new opportunities and challenges.

Finally, Yan (2025), Santamarina (2025), Fragoso (2022), and Luo (2024) emphasize that lifestyles are not only shaped by politics but can also influence it, actively contributing





to the formation and transformation of political institutions. These studies reveal a dynamic, bidirectional relationship between politics and lifestyle, shaped by a range of social, economic, and technological factors.

CONTEMPORARY RELEVANCE

In a global context marked by political polarization, misinformation, and intensified use of social media, understanding how young people position themselves politically—and how such positioning shapes their life choices (in areas such as consumption, civic engagement, education, and health)—is essential for public policy, civic education, and democratic governance.

The manuscript engages with a relevant and up-to-date bibliography, incorporating diverse perspectives—from Marxist analyses to studies on the impact of social media—thereby enriching the understanding of the complex interplay between politics and youth lifestyle.

Despite certain limitations, such as overly descriptive sections, repetitive conclusions, and conceptual connections that could be better developed, the study stands out for the relevance and timeliness of its theme.

In summary, this is a promising piece of work that makes a meaningful contribution to political, educational, and cultural studies focused on youth and deserves recognition for its potential academic and social impact.
